- Any consignment must comply with all other conditions stated on the authorisation TARP(S) 2024/12, or the equivalent TARP authorisation/General Licence (issued by APHA) for consignments that landed at a port or airport in England.
- A copy of the authorisation TARP(S)2024/12 (or equivalent TARP authorisation/ General Licence) should accompany this letter.
